### COLLEGE POLICY: GOOD ACADEMIC STANDING IN THE COLLEGE

Each Autumn and Winter semester Pre-University Science students must pass the equivalent of a full-time course load (four courses).

Students who fail to comply with the College Policy for the first time will be placed on Academic Probation. Students who have previously been on Academic Probation in this Program or any other Program will be suspended from the College.

Students who fail to comply with the Additional Program Standing Requirements for a second time will not be permitted to continue in the Science program and must request a program change.
