PROVINCE	DIPLOMA	REQUIRED MINIMUM SCHOLARITY (PROMOTION TO GRADE 12 IF NOT COMPLETED)
Alberta	General High School Diploma	Successfully completed Grade 11 Cumulative credits between 67 and 100
British Columbia	High School Graduation Diploma	Successfully completed Grade 11
Manitoba	High School Diploma	Successfully completed Grade 11 with no fewer than 13 credits
New Brunswick	High School Graduation Diploma (Grade 12)	Successfully completed Grade 11 with a total number of credits between 12 and 17 or 13 and 19, depending on the "régime"
Newfoundland	High School Graduation Diploma	Grade 12 with between 24 and 36 credits OR Successfully completed Grade 11 with a minimum of 24 credits
Nova Scotia	High School Diploma (Grade 12)	Successfully completed Grade 11 with a High School Certificate and a minimum of 12 credits OR Successfully completed Grade 11 with a Vocational High School Certificate and a minimum of 12 credits
Ontario	Ontario Secondary School Diploma	Successfully Grade 11 Ontario Secondary School with a minimum of 22 credits
Prince Edward Island	General High School Diploma	Successfully completed Grade 11 with a minimum of 12 credits
Saskatchewan	High School Graduation Diploma	Successfully completed Grade 11 with a minimum of 16 credits
