# Communications: Art, Media, Theatre

The Communications: Art, Media, Theatre program at Vanier is an option in Creative Arts, Literature and Languages. It is distinctive in that it offers a balance between studio and theory in four interrelated disciplines: studio arts; film and media studies; photography; and theatre. As a result, students get a broadly based knowledge set which helps in acceptance to university programs requiring a portfolio of creative and academic work. As well, in the Portfolio Class, students build a portfolio they can use for admission to certain university programs.

Our exceptional facilities include a Mac-based Media lab for video editing and digital design as well as a theatre studio, fully equipped photo lab, cinema screening room, and painting, drawing and sculpture studios. The program area includes display spaces as well as the Henry Lehmann Gallery where selected student art is shown in weekly exhibitions.

## What can I do after I graduate with a DEC in Communications?

A DEC in Communications prepares you for university studies in areas such as art education, art history, art therapy, film studies, fine arts, communication studies, film animation and production, graphic design, and journalism.



## Admission Requirements:

Admission to the College is on the basis of the Quebec Secondary School Diploma (*Diplôme d'études secondaires*), or the Quebec Diploma of Vocational Education (*Diplôme d'études professionnelles*) with Secondary 5 first and second languages as well as Secondary 4 Mathematics; or equivalent scholarship completed outside the province.

Admissions to Communications: Art, Media, Theatre is open to all; no prior experience in art or media is necessary. No portfolio is required.
