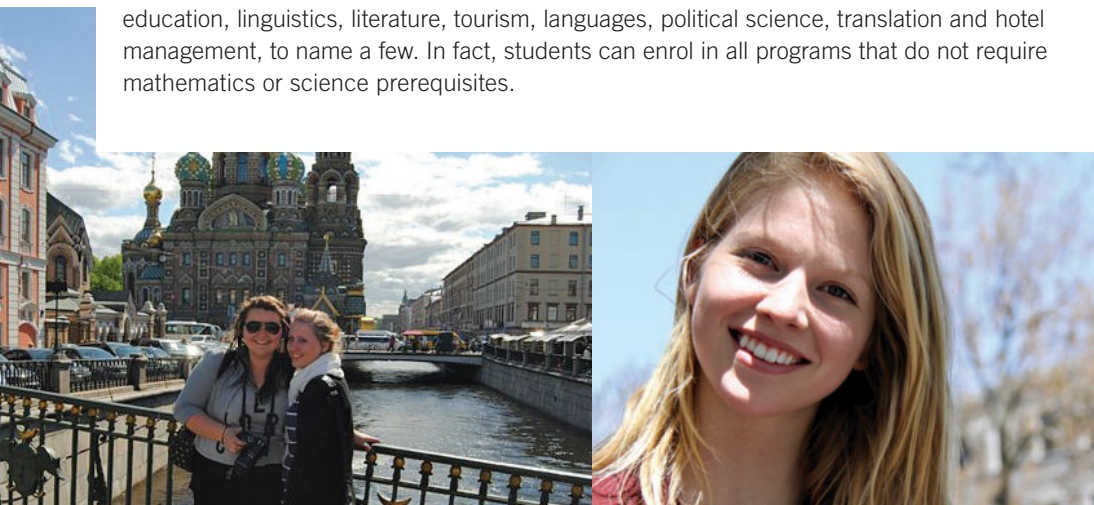
The Department of Modern Languages at Vanier College prepares students for university by offering the chance to become proficient in Italian, Spanish, German, Mandarin and/or Russian. Students may concentrate on as many as two or three foreign languages and take a total of eight courses chosen from these five languages. In addition to learning modern languages, students will take six program courses and expand their cultural knowledge and learn about key notions of language and linguistics.

Vanier College's Modern Languages students benefit from a small, friendly program that provides individual attention for those who need it. The program facilitates the adjustment to Cegep by offering a faculty advisor or mentor to every entering student. Students enjoy topnotch facilities: a state-of-the-art language lab and an attractive student lounge and study area.

The Modern Languages Program offers students the possibility of exchange programs and trips abroad to such places as Russia, Germany and China. Students may also participate in the exciting Slavic Studies College-wide major.

What can I do after I graduate with a DEC in Modern Languages?

Modern Languages is an excellent preparation for university studies in areas such as law, education, linguistics, literature, tourism, languages, political science, translation and hotel management, to name a few. In fact, students can enrol in all programs that do not require mathematics or science prerequisites.



Admission Requirements:

Admission to the College is on the basis of the Quebec Secondary School Diploma (*Diplôme d'études secondaires*); or the Quebec Diploma of Vocational Education (*Diplôme d'études professionnelles*) with Secondary 5 first and second languages as well as Secondary 4 Mathematics; or equivalent scholarship completed outside the province.
