Programs offered for evening and weekend courses

Science Diploma of Collegial Studies (DCS) – 200.B0

A DCS in Science is excellent preparation for many areas of university studies including fields like engineering, medicine or ecology but also for topics as diverse as finance and education.

Social Sciences Diploma of Collegial Studies (DCS) – 300.AA

A DCS in Social Sciences involves the study and research of human behavior. This provides a solid background for future endeavors at the university level.

Early Childhood Education (ECE) Attestation of Collegial Studies (ACS) – JEE.0K

Accounting Attestation of Collegial Studies (ACS) – LCA.8N

Management Attestation of Collegial Studies (ACS) – LCA.8P

Please note that beginning Autumn 2015, NO NEW ADMISSION WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Springboard to a DCS – 081.C1

This program is for students who need to need to make up missing prerequisite courses in order to apply to a DCS. Students can only stay in this program for a maximum of 3 consecutive semesters. Students can be either part-time or full-time.

Note: Full-time students cannot be guaranteed.

Requalification to a DCS – 081.C2

This program is for students who need to need to improve their academic standing. Students can only stay in this program for a maximum of 3 consecutive semesters.

Independent Studies – 080.02

This is for students who are not following a program of studies and are interested in taking one or two courses or for students who will be taking the Family Home Daycare course. As this is not a program of studies, additional course fees will be charged to the student.

Cégep à la carte (CALC) – 080.CA

For students who need to upgrade skills in the area of Business. Note that all of your courses must have the extension CALC in the title in order to be valid.

University Pre-requisites – 080.04

This is for students who need to take specific courses required for entry in to a university.
