**Notice to Employees and Students who are Pregnant,
or who have chronic conditions such as diabetes, heart disease, Chron's Disease, asthma
or whose immune system is affected by illness or an immunosuppressive treatment.**

The incidents of reported H1N1 cases in Vanier College are becoming more numerous. If you are pregnant or have a chronic condition you are asked to consult with your attending physician to determine the best precautionary measures you should follow.

You are encouraged to meet with your attending physician. Depending on the conditions set in the recommendation by the attending physician, please advise Human Resources. Staff of Human Resources will alert the administrative unit of the employee concerning the recommendations for the employee and the need for replacement measures.

Students

Students are encouraged to meet with their attending physician. The physician can determine if a preventive leave is recommended. If a preventive leave of three (3) weeks or more is deemed necessary, the student will submit this recommendation with a completed [medical incomplete form](#) to the Office of the Registrar (H-100; 514-744-7100, registrars@vaniercollege.qc.ca; or 821 Ste Croix, Montreal, QC H4L 3X9) Approved preventive leave recommendations will receive a Medical Incomplete designation for each registered A09 course.

Staff of the Office of the Registrar will inform the appropriate Faculty Dean or Continuing Education Coordinator to ensure that program coordinators and teachers are informed as necessary.
